

EA Band Rules of Conduct – General

- **Students are reminded that all disciplinary rules and requirements contained in the EA Student Handbook apply at all times, and that violation of those rules and regulations will be dealt with accordingly.**
- **Students are expected to act appropriately and with dignity and respect at all times, remembering that while you are in uniform or at an event with the Band, you are representing your Band, your school, your family and your community.**
- **Students are expected to address teachers, parents, chaperones and staff as Mr., Mrs., Miss or Ms., and comply with all requests and instructions.**
- **Students are expected to cooperate with chaperones in the same way they are expected to cooperate with teachers and staff.**
- **Students are expected to provide a good example to one another, particularly upper classmen with lower classmen.**
- **Whether on the bus, in the stands or elsewhere, there will be no swearing, no foul talk, and no use of any alcohol or other prohibited substance.**
- **On the busses and in the stands, students are expected to be seated and to refrain from any horseplay that could result in damage or injury.**
- **Unless otherwise specified, students must be accompanied by a chaperone when going to use the restroom.**
- **These rules are not meant to be restrictive or burdensome, but rather are designed to create a safe, positive atmosphere and experience for all to enjoy.**
- **Students are reminded that participation in the Band is a privilege and NOT a right. This privilege may be revoked by failing to follow these Rules of Conduct.**
